

The reason you do not have to swipe the card is that it submits credit card information by radio frequency identification. Now the hackers have come up with a way to then "swipe" your information through the air. They have the means with a special computer and RFID reader along with a hidden battery. They hack your credit card and replicate it with a card writer.

One way to stand up to them is to get an affordable RFID blocking wallet or purse to keep your credit cards safe from this type of hacker. If you are into the "wave and pay" make sure you have the "safe and secure" means to protect your card.
