## How to Avoid Cyber Pick-Pocketing

You may find yourself face to face with a pick pocket, and not even be aware of it. We are talking about cyber pick-pocketing. These new wave and pay credit cards are not only fancy, but they can be pick pocketed in a “New York Minute”.

The reason you do not have to swipe the card is that it submits credit card information by radio frequency identification. Now the hackers have come up with a way to then “swipe” your information through the air. They have the means with a special computer and RFID reader along with a hidden battery. They hack your credit card and replicate it with a card writer.

One way to stand up to them is to get an affordable RFID blocking wallet or purse to keep your credit cards safe from this type of hacker. If you are into the “wave and pay” make sure you have the “safe and secure” means to protect your card.

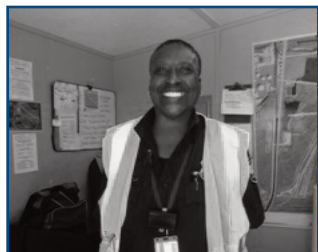

Officer Janice Norris has been with Weiser Security for three years. She started working at a new site in January, her first night on duty at her new post she stopped a theft in progress.

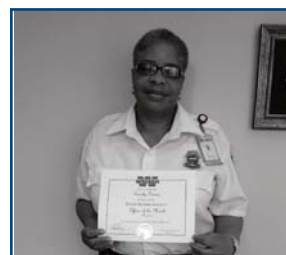
