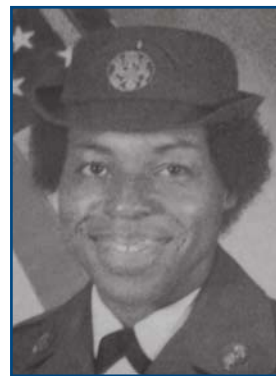
Weiser Recognizes Veterans

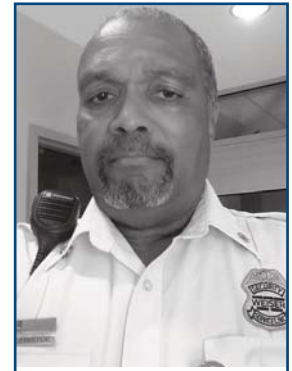
